Stopping the Violence or Women's Counselling is offered to women over 18 years of age.

We provide a safe environment where any aspect of abuse can be discussed in confidence. Abuse includes experience as a child, youth or as an adult and includes sexual, physical, emotional, psychological, spiritual, financial and other behaviours that disempower women.

Our goal is to help women understand themselves and to gain confidence in making choices.
